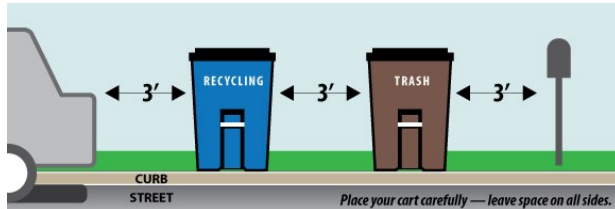

Trash & Recyclables

Trash will be picked up **EVERY FRIDAY**.

Recycles will be picked up **EVERY OTHER FRIDAY**. (*Opposite Friday of Bulk Waste*)

Bulk Waste will be picked up **EVERY OTHER FRIDAY**. (*Opposite Friday of Recyclables*)



- Please have all cans/items at curb by 6am!
- **All items must be placed INSIDE the Garbage Can.**
- The schedule for the Recyclables and Bulk Waste will be posted on your water bill each month for reference as well as on the Town website <http://mtpleasantnc.org>

Items WASTE PRO will Pick-up:

Bulk Items Accepted (*only on bulk weeks*)

(*have at curb by 6am Friday morning*)

- Chairs
- Entertainment centers (*without glass only*)
- Foot boards
- Head boards
- Small couches (*No sleeper sofas*)
- Small tables
- Mattress and box springs

****Large PILES of items will not be picked up****

Bulk Items that will NOT be picked up:

- All Appliances
- Any materials resulting from work performed by a commercial contractor
- Automobile parts including motors, tires on rims, doors, fenders, car seats, batteries, bumpers
- Bricks
- Cardboard boxes. Please cut down to 3 feet by 3 feet (or smaller) pieces and place in the recycling cart for collection
- Central air conditioning or heating units
- Ceramic tile
- Chain link fencing
- Cinderblocks or concrete
- Computer monitors
- Construction Debris
- Dirt or Sand
- Duct or sheet metal materials
- Fencing (wood and/or metal including posts)
- Fire-damaged items
- Grocery carts
- Floor coverings (carpet, vinyl, hardwoods)
- Marble or simulated marble countertops
- Nails or boards with protruding nails
- Paint & other hazardous waste
- Plaster
- Propane/oxygen tanks
- Railroad ties
- Rocks
- Roofing materials, shingles
- Sheetrock
- Televisions
- Tires
- Toilets
- Window air-condition units

More about Recycling

IT'S ALL ABOUT SHAPE AND SIZE

Recycling sorting machines recognize the **shape** of containers and "see" bottles, tubs, jugs, jars, cans, cartons and paper. If it isn't one of these shapes, it doesn't belong in the recycling bin. **Size** matters, too. If the material is tiny, the machines have to filter it out. If it is too big, it hurts the machinery.

<p>Bottles, tubs, jugs and jars</p>  <p>No pumps Empty and rinse</p> <p>No lids, straws, single-use cups, six-pack rings, to-go containers or pouches</p> 	<p>All cans</p>  <p>Empty and rinse</p> <p>No scrap/mixed metals such as ladders, pots or hangers</p> 	<p>Bottles and jars</p>  <p>Empty and rinse</p> <p>No mirrors, windows or glassware</p> 	<p>Paper, cartons and cardboard</p>  <p>Flatten cardboard</p> <p>No small paper pieces and packaging, or shredded paper</p>

Do you know **NOT** to bag your recyclables when placing them in the cart? Here are other actions you can take to prepare your recyclables for the recycling facility. Keep recycling right! Get Cart Smart!

 <p>Please screw on caps.</p>	<p>No lids. Place in trash.</p> 
 <p>Please recycle only <i>clean</i> pizza boxes.</p>	<p>No greasy pizza boxes. Place in compost.</p> 
 <p>Please recycle <i>paper</i> egg cartons.</p>	<p>No Styrofoam or plastic egg cartons. Place in trash.</p> 
 <p>Please recycle <i>clean</i> aluminum foil.</p>	<p>No dirty aluminum foil. Rinse and reuse, or place in trash.</p>
