Leaves

Loose Leaf pickup will be November - January each year

Loose leaves must be placed at the curb for the crew to vacuum the leaves up. Do not bag your leaves during this time period.

Each resident will have three (3) opportunities for loose leaf pickup between November and January on their designated week.



Bagged Leaves should be placed at the curb all other times of the year (February-October).

These types of yard debris WILL NOT be picked up by the Town or WastePro.

- ⇒ Limbs larger than <u>6 feet</u> long or <u>4 inches</u> in diameter
- ⇒ Stumps
- ⇒ Root balls
- ⇒ Lumber (treated or untreated)
- ⇒ Fencing (wood, vinyl, or metal)
- ⇒ Landscape timbers
- ⇒ Railroad ties
- ⇒ Tree trunks (larger than 4 inches in diameter)
- ⇒ Pallets

Yard Debris Guidelines & Schedule



Limb, Leaf, and Brush pick-up will be ONE Tuesday each month per address.

If Public Works is unable to pickup on Tuesday of your week due to water/sewer emergencies, scheduling conflicts, bad weather, or holidays, it will be by Friday of your assigned week. Any limbs, leaves, or brush placed after 7am on Tuesday may not be picked up, if the crew has already been on your street for the week. It would then remain until the following month.

Residents no longer need to call to schedule a yard debris pickup.

Tree Limbs

- Limbs must be no longer than six (6) feet in length and 4 inches in diameter.
- Absolutely no stumps or large logs will be permitted.
- Limbs should be placed parallel to the curbside in separate piles for faster pick-up.
 Please provide one (1) foot between piles.
- No limbs are to be bagged as trash or placed in trashcans at any time.
- Please do not place limbs on tarps.
- NO COMMERCIALLY CUT TREES/LIMBS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- NO Treated Wood, Building Materials, Pallets, or Landscape Timbers will be accepted!

Pine Cones & Acorns

Pine cones and acorns should be left in containers or on a tarp by the curb. **PLEASE do not dump them on the street**, since it is difficult for workers to safely pick them up. The crew will leave your container by the curb once they are emptied.

Grass Clippings, Pine Needles, & Bush Trimmings

- Grass Clippings, Pine Needles, and Bush Trimmings must be placed in clear garbage bags or on top of a tarp then placed at curbside and separated from other yard waste, household trash, or other items.
- Do not put more than 50lbs on the tarp.
- Clippings or bagged clippings should not be placed into trash cans.
- NO COMMERCIALLY CUT GRASS CLIPPINGS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Any of the items listed above, excluding tree limbs, that are not on a tarp, bagged, or in a container will not be picked up.
